Membership in the Mississippi Watercolor Society (MSWS) is open to both residents and non-residents of Mississippi who are interested in promoting the art of watercolor, and fostering a greater appreciation and interest in watercolor as a major medium by both the artists and the viewing public.

Dues are \$35 per year. The membership year begins July 1 and ends June 30. There is no pro-rating of dues. Dues and contributions to MSWS are tax deductible.

We welcome beginners. MSWS membership is open to anyone with an interest in watercolor, regardless of experience. There is no jurying requirement for membership. Watercolor includes other water-based media such as acrylic, casein, gouache and egg tempera.

Membership includes newsletters, regular scheduled meetings, participation in the annual Member's Show, and invitations to MSWS sponsored workshops and the Grand National reception of members and exhibiting artists.

Regular meetings provide an opportunity for members to meet other artists, observe demonstrations of painting techniques, either by a local artist or by video, and keep up with art of watercolor in Mississippi.

Each member will also receive a prospectus for the annual MSWS Grand National Exhibition held at the Mississippi Museum of Art. In addition, members in good standing also receive a full-color catalog of the paintings accepted in the Grand National.
